

question may really be a sincere question coming from innocent people but in our gospel it was with malice. The intention of the query was only to test how knowledgeable Jesus was about the Scriptures.

To love God wholly and totally (with one's heart, soul and mind) and to love one's neighbour are the greatest commandments of all. These two are inseparable. One cannot say "I love God" but hate his/her neighbour or have nothing to do with his/her neighbour. Because God is love and that is why we are able to love.

To love is to serve; to serve lovingly our brothers and sisters, especially those who are in need in our midst. By serving others one expresses his/her authentic love to God. There are a lot of ways of showing our love for God and others, we don't need to go out and look outside of ourselves, especially during this pandemic.

In our family, how do we show our love and share the joy of love? How do we show our care and concern to our parents, siblings, partners (wives and husbands) and friends?

When we make everyone happy and content with who they are and what they have and what they can - that is love. Loving is accepting who you are and who other people are. Loving is serving our family with full dedication and joy, without complaints and regrets.

Loving God is abstract unless it leads us to serving our community and others. Our community may mean our neighbourhood community or our parish community, or our group or club community. Are we good neighbours? How do we share our time, talents and treasures to our community? How are we involved in building our community? Are we an active member in our community or just a spectator to what is going on?

Loving is also a call to fidelity, becoming faithful to your one true love who is God. You can only love the "One" who is love. It is because of the love of God for us, who is actually the first one to love us, that we are able to love.

Fidelity to God means being faithful to His will, doing his holy will in love. When someone does something that he/she thinks is good without the right motivation, he/she will not endure. But if someone does things out of love, then he/she will grow and last. The main enemy of love is narcissism. When someone is so engrossed with himself/herself, his/her ego becomes the centre of his/her life. He/she can then no longer see others and God.

As a parish community we express our love to God by coming together to worship him and supporting each other sharing our time, talent and treasure. God uses our gifts to feed others specially this time. May our heart and hands be strengthened to Love God; share his love with others in different forms.

### First Reading

Exodus 20:20-26

The Lord said to Moses, 'Tell the sons of Israel this, "You must not molest the stranger or oppress him, for you lived as strangers in the land of Egypt. You must not be harsh with the widow, or with the orphan; if you are harsh with them, they will surely cry out to me, and be sure I shall hear their cry; my anger will flare and I shall kill you with the sword, your own wives will be widows, your own children orphans."

"If you lend money to any of my people, to any poor man among you, you must not play the usurer with him: you must not demand interest from him. "If you take another's cloak as a pledge, you must give it back to him before sunset. It is all the covering he has; it is the cloak he wraps his body in; what else would he sleep in? If he cries to me, I will listen, for I am full of pity."

### Second Reading

Thessalonians 1:5-10

You observed the sort of life we lived when we were with you, which was for your instruction, and you were led to become imitators of us, and of the Lord; and it was with the joy of the Holy Spirit that you took to the gospel, in spite of the great opposition all round you. This has made you the great example to all believers in Macedonia and Achaia since it was from you that the word of the Lord started to spread – and not only throughout Macedonia and Achaia, for the news of your faith in God has spread everywhere. We do not need to tell other people about it: other people tell us how we started the work among you, how you broke with idolatry when you were converted to God and became servants of the real, living God; and how you are now waiting for Jesus, his Son, whom he raised from the dead, to come from heaven to save us from the retribution which is coming.

The second resembles it: you must love your neighbour as yourself. On these two commandments hang the whole Law, and the Prophets also.'


